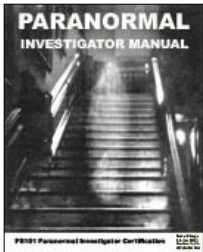
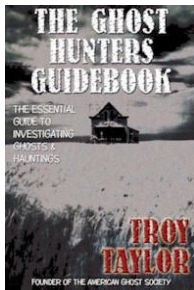


Courses in the Paranormal Studies department at Flamel College are currently offered through correspondence study only. Each course consists of a manual, lessons, investigative forms, a research project, and a final examination. Students completing PS101 successfully will be issued a certificate and an identification card in **Paranormal Investigation**. PS201 awards a certificate in **Advanced Paranormal Investigation**. Those completing PS102 will receive a certificate and photo identification card in **UFO Investigation**. If desired, successful students in the investigation courses will be listed as qualified investigators in directories and online resources. Students completing PS212 will be certified in **Parapsychology** and those completing PS301 will become **Certified EVP Technicians**. Those completing P313 will be certified as **Cryptozoologists**. To receive the **Diploma in Paranormal Studies**, students must complete any three courses in this department. 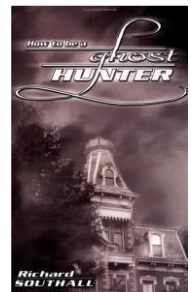


## PS101 & PS201 - Paranormal Investigator Certification

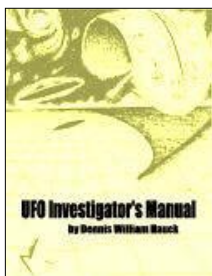
The Paranormal Investigator courses are designed for students wishing to conduct paranormal investigations and research ghost sightings, survival of the soul, poltergeist activity, and voice, electronic, and photographic evidence of paranormal activity. Included are proprietary manuals to guide you step-by-step through your studies and textbooks ([How to Be a Ghost Hunter](#) for PS101 and [The Ghost Hunter's Guidebook](#) for PS201). An electronic (EMF) ghost hunting device is included with PS101, so you can start your investigations immediately. The textbooks for these courses provide forms, contact information for numerous paranormal organizations, and sources for hard-to-find equipment. Both textbooks contain actual photographs of orbs and apparitions, and PS201 comes with a DVD of an actual investigation as well as a Resource CD of ghosthunting software and ebooks. These illustrated field-guides for paranormal researchers are the only handbooks that detail so many practical facets of conducting investigations, including how to find and research suspected haunted areas. **Tuition: \$95** (for either PS101 or PS201). **Includes all materials.**

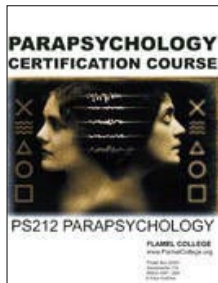
## PS102 - UFO Investigator Certification



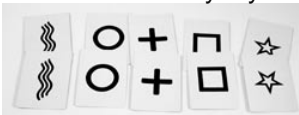
This course is designed for students wishing to conduct investigations or research into UFO sightings, abduction reports, animal mutilations, crop circles, and government knowledge of extraterrestrial visitations. Successful candidates will be granted a certificate, issued an identification card, and listed in directories of UFOinvestigators. This course is one of the most respected in this field and is taught by ufologist Bruce Schaffer, former president of the International UFO Registry (IUFOR) and editor of the *Journal of UFOlogy*. The UFO Investigator Certification course includes the [UFO Investigator's Manual](#) and the textbook [Reaching for Reality](#) by close encounter therapist Constance Clear. All candidates for certification must demonstrate their ability to investigate a local or historical case objectively and submit an acceptable Investigative Report. After passing the final examination, the student will receive his or her certificate and professional laminated ID. **Tuition: \$65. Includes all materials.**

## PS212 - Parapsychologist Certification



This class is the final requirement to receive the Diploma in Paranormal Studies but may be taken at any time. Parapsychology is the scientific study of paranormal phenomena. The "paranormal" (literally "beyond the normal") refers to exceptional human experiences that do not seem to be explainable in terms of our everyday understanding or known scientific principles. Paranormal experiences often seem weird, uncanny, or unnatural, but are really part of a hidden part of nature of which we are not aware. Topics include: Extrasensory Perception; Telepathy; Clairvoyance and Clairaudience; Psychometry; Precognition and Premonitions; Remote Viewing; Channeling and Mediumship; Dowsing;

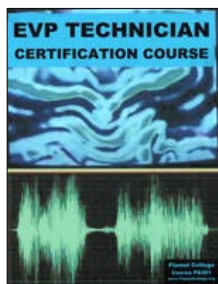

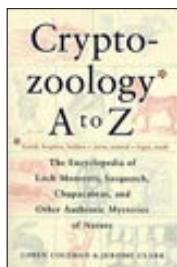
